COVID-19 Symptomatic Decision Tree

Section #1

Exposure to a confirmed positive case of COVID-19	Asymptomatic	Return after 5 days (this equates to day 6) from the date of last exposure so long as you remain symptom-free.	(There is no option to test out and return early).
	Symptomatic	See section #2	

Section #2

Symptomatic or COVID-19 positive	Return after:	<p>5 days have passed (this equates to day 6) since symptom onset, student has had no fever for a minimum of 24 hours and is otherwise symptom-free. Masks are to be worn for an additional 5 days upon their return.</p> <p>*Although a negative COVID test is not required upon return, it is strongly recommended.</p>

Section #3

Students with prior COVID-19 infections.	If you have had a positive case in the last 90 days or are fully vaccinated (within the last 6 months), or have been boosted:	No action required. However, please note that if the entire class must quarantine, then you must also adhere to the quarantine time frame (but you do not need to get tested).
	If you are symptomatic:	See Section #2

Antigen/PCR Tests will both be accepted.

*Additionally, please understand that we will not offer a hybrid academic program in the case of illness. We will only move to an online format if the **entire class** is under quarantine. This will allow the affected child/children to convalesce. Work may be sent home to be done independently in the chance that the child is able to do so.*
